The Gleaning Project

The Gleaning Project is a volunteer powered program of Harvest Pierce County that works to reduce the amount of produce wasted in our community, provide more fresh food to those in need, and build community. We harvest from farms, urban fruit trees, and farmers markets with excess produce and donate the harvest to food banks and meal sites. Volunteers also get to take home a portion of the harvested produce at most gleans.

Community Food Projects

Pierce County boasts a network of over ninety-five community gardens, orchards, and food forests. Harvest Pierce County works to support these gardens in several ways.

- Facilitate the creation of new gardens and other food projects throughout Pierce County
- Build capacity among volunteers through training, networking opportunities, and one-on-one support.
- Engage our community in the work of a just and healthy food system through celebratory and informational events.
- Provide relevant, accessible education on topics related to community gardening and fruit tree care.

Tips for Donating

- **Always try to call before donating produce, even if the donation hours are listed.** If you are donating regularly, we encourage you to develop a relationship with your donation site and find out about their specific needs.
- Harvest your crops early in the morning on the day that you will be delivering for optimum freshness.
- Inspect each item for freshness. No bruising, insect damage, or over-ripeness!
- If possible, wash, weigh, and record all donations for your records.
- Never leave produce at a food bank if no one is there unless you have been told to do so.
- *Every vegetable counts!* If you are willing to make the trip, food banks are happy to accept even the smallest donation (though hot meal sites usually need larger amounts). However, if you are growing specifically for a food bank, it is best to grow more of one type of produce than a variety.

***NOTE:** Cooking apples are apples that need to be cooked before eating and would not be eaten fresh

You are encouraged to be creative with how you share excess produce. This list is a great starting point but do not be afraid to reach out to other people like nursing homes, community centers, and your neighbors!
